



## **Checklist** – How to prepare for your windows delivery and installation

Before your windows and doors are delivered, there are a number of things you should consider to make sure it all happens smoothly. Start with defining with the distributor a suitable day/time for your windows and doors to be delivered, and make sure you are on site that day.

## Windows delivery:

>	Where are your windows and doors going to be dropped off?
	$\square$ Find out If you need to free up space in your driveway or garage
	☐ If so, how much space should it be?
>	Ask about the timeframe from delivery to installation
	$\square$ How long does it take from the time of delivery until they are installed?
	$\square$ Do you need to do something to protect the new windows from wind and weather while they are still on the pallet?
	Ask who is responsible for the windows and doors once they have been unloaded from the van, until it's time to install them
٧	/indows installation:
>	Do you need to make some arrangements in your garden to make it easier to get the windows to where
	they need to be installed – for example by pruning a bush, moving the trampoline or your garden furniture?
	$\square$ How can you prepare the room where the windows will be installed?
	☐ Do you need to cover up furniture? If so, how?
>	Check what it is included in your installation package
	$\square$ Is the opening preparation included in your installation package?
	☐ If you are removing old windows to have new ones installed, does the package also include other things like, for example, brickwork repairing?
	☐ Who is going to remove waste and materials used during installation?
	$\Box$ If one or more of these things are not included - is this something you want your distributor to help you with? And can he do it?
>	Check the quality on the installation
	$\square$ Once your windows and doors have been installed, check they open correctly.
	☐ Does the job carried out meet your expectations?

☐ Make sure you are aware of terms and conditions of your warranty on both the windows and the installation.
