

In 1952 VELUX façade windows were launched, but it's only 10 years later that VELUX vertical windows changed their name to **VELFAC** (ventilation, light, facade), which was registered as a trademark in 1962.

Today, VELFAC and VELUX are both subsidiaries of VKR Holding, the worldwide group of companies which altogether employs 17,200 people in 38 countries and supply their complementary ranges of high-quality windows to customers across the globe.

Is designed to reduce solar gain and glare, and is ideal for South or West facing facades, or large areas of glass. VELFAC SUN reflects up to 60% of the sun's heat while allowing plenty of natural light to enter the interior.







